Mail Center Information

For all new residents, there are 2 mail centers here at Rainbow RV Resort. The Main center is located at the west end of the Main Clubhouse near the pickle ball courts. Sites 1-350 will have boxes at this center. All packages are held at the Main mail center. The second mail center for sites 351-499 is at the Back Clubhouse. All doublewide home sites 363-399 have mail delivered to their site. If you receive a slip saying you have a package too large for your mailbox, you can pick up your package at the Main mail center Mon.—Fri. between **12 NOON—3:00PM Only**. This means that during these 3 hours, **barring unforeseen circumstances**, I will be there so that you don't make a wasted trip to retrieve a package. You can probably find me after 12 noon at the Main center, but note that I also have to sort mail at the back mail center. This year the mail is delivered to Rainbow from the Frostproof P.O. and the delivery times vary. So far around 3 pm is the average to get your mail. Mondays have been somewhat later due to the volume because we do not have Saturday delivery. I hope this information will help you in understanding how the mail system works here at Rainbow RV Resort. DALE

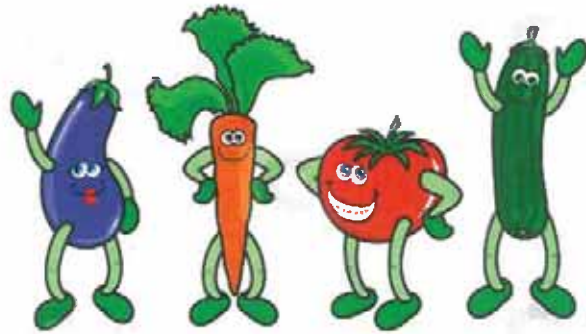

**Seats are sold at individual tables.

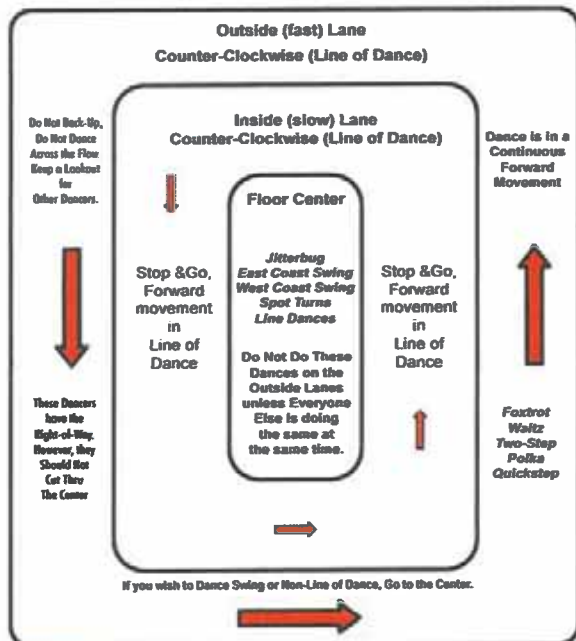
