Here at Slickrock Campground, we are currently undergoing a large capital expenditure project to improve the property and, in turn, the guest experience.

The biggest piece of this project is a complete infrastructure overhaul—upgrading the electric, water and sewer services throughout the campground. This project has just recently begun and will continue off-and-on through the first week of September 2020. We are doing our best to keep things running as smoothly as possible during this time, but feel the need to inform you of some changes to expect when visiting our campground between now and then:

- The main entrance to the campground will be closed for a few weeks. There is an alternate entrance just past the Atomic Grill, a couple hundred feet south of where our entrance typically is; there is a sign denoting this temporary entrance.
- If no one is at the check-in table near the temporary entrance, please park and walk to the front office or call the resort to be assisted by a team member at (435) 259-7660.
- If you arrive after hours, your check-in packet will be in a box by the check-in table mentioned above; this packet will contain a map showing directions to your site.
- The camp store and pool will remain open; please follow the marked walkway, which will lead you there.
